**PSAT testing** on October

12th is for those high school students who are currently taking or have finished geometry. It is a practice SAT that is given at our school. The test will take most of the morning to complete. Students have received practice material to prepare for the test. We will send a letter home in early October to sign up for the test. The cost is \$14.
