Aug 18	Matthew 6:9	After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.
Aug 25	Matthew 6:10	Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.
Sep 1	Matthew 6:11	Give us this day our daily bread.
Sep 8	Matthew 6:12	And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.
Sep 15	Matthew 6:13	And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever.
Sep 22	Psalms 121:1	I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help.
Sep 29	Psalms 121:2	My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth.
Oct 6	Psalms 121:3	He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: he that keepeth thee will not slumber.
Oct 13	Psalms 121:4	Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep.
Oct 20	Psalms 121:5	The LORD is thy keeper: the LORD is thy shade upon thy right hand.
Oct 27	Psalms 121:6	The sun shall not smite thee by day, nor the moon by night.
Nov 3	Psalms 121:7	The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil; he shall preserve thy soul.
Nov 10	Psalms 121:8	The Lord shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.
Nov 17	Psalms 92:1	It is a good thing to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High:
Nov 23	Psalms 106:1	Praise ye the LORD. O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Dec 1	Luke 2:11	For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.
Dec 8	Luke 2:12	And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger.
Dec 15	Luke 2:13 & 14	And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.
Jan 5	Psalm 1:1	Blessed is the man that walketh not in counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.
Jan 12	Psalm 1:2	But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.
Jan 19	Psalm 1:3	And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither, and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.
Jan 26	Psalm 1:4	The ungodly are not so; but are like the chaff which the wind driveth away.
Feb 2	Psalm 1:5	Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.
Feb 9	Psalm 1:6	For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous; but the way of the ungodly shall perish.
Feb 16	Matthew 7:7	Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:
Feb 23	Psalm 103:1	Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name.
Mar 1	I John 4:8	He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love.
Mar 22	Philippians 4:13	I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.
Mar 29	Psalm 100:1	Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands.
Apr 5	Psalm 100:2	Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing.

Apr 26	Psalm 100:3	Know ye that the LORD he is God; it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.
May 3	Psalm 100:4	Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.
